

Child Protection Conference Information for Children (7-10 years)

There will be a meeting called a Child Protection Conference happening for you soon.

What is a child protection conference?

This is a meeting where people such as your teachers, doctor, nurse, social worker and family will get together to talk because there are worries about your safety.

These people will talk about what is going well for you and what else could be done to make things better. If something is happening that shouldn't be, they will talk about how to make it stop.

They will make a plan of things that everyone needs to do to help keep you safe and happy.

It is important that we hear your thoughts and feelings at the meeting. Your Social Worker will speak to you about how best to do this. You could attend for part of the meeting, ask someone to share them at the meeting for you or you could write down anything you want the meeting to know about.

It is important that they know:

1. Things that make you happy and smile
2. Things that make you worried / sad / cry /angry
3. Things that you would like changed to make you feel safe and happy?

Further meetings will take place in the future to check that you are still safe and happy.
