# Safeguarding children and young people is everyone's responsibility.

We have a mission to support children and families so they can get the best outcomes in life.

As employees within Schools and Learning we are required to undertake safeguarding training to prepare us for the unique role that we play in achieving the vision that *children* and *young* people will be happy, healthy, safe and confident in their future.

The training pathway has been developed so that we can determine a bespoke pathway with both mandatory training and recommended further professional development training to ensure we all have the knowledge and skills to keep children safe.

Each of us will be able to identify with our line manager the professional group (groups A to E based on our contact with children and families and our management responsibilities) to which we belong. This will enable us to plan our own training and our line manager to plan team training.

Line Managers are required to maintain a record of safeguarding training undertaken by their team and submit this annually for audit in the required format. This will enable Schools and Learning to deliver and/or commission safeguarding training to meet the needs of the workforce.
